# **Coaching Report**

- A Competition Development Squash Coaching Course was delivered November 2022 in Moncton. It was sponsored, in part, by Squash Canada and SNS. Janet MacLeod co facilitated this course and was successfully evaluated for this facilitation. There were 2 course participants from NS -Chris Lien and Tim Loat. (There was also 1 from PE and 4 from NB).
- Janet MacLeod was successfully evaluated as an Evaluator at the Intro to Competition level in November 2022
- Janet MacLeod has been certified the Community Squash Course level as a Master Coach Developer (MCD)
- Two Community Squash Courses were delivered: March 2022 to 4 course participants in Sydney Cape Breton and April 2022 to 5 participants (Women) in Cole Harbour.
- Janet MacLeod is now trained to deliver the Multi Sport course Make Ethical Decisions which all coaches are required to take. She delivered this to the 5 women Community Course participants in May 2023.
